



Activity 1 - The discovery café

Objective

To work in groups on a number of pre-selected questions.

Materials

- Enough tables and chairs to accommodate all participants
- Paper and pens

Number of participants

Time

From 4 to 20 people

Half a day to a full day, alternating working groups of no more than 30'.

The café-découverte is a **participative method**, inspired by the "World Café", which encourages informal exchanges around specific themes. In a convivial setting, participants discuss in small groups, changing tables at regular intervals to multiply perspectives and share ideas.

A facilitator guides the discussions, and a collective summary is made at the end of the session.

Benefits:

- Encourages active participation.
- Encourages sharing of ideas and experiences.
- Strengthens cohesion among participants.

We suggest you use this animation to answer the CQQCOQP questions (How, what, who, how much, where, when, why) on the mind map.

- 1. Form groups
- 2. Assign one or two questions to each table
- 3. Divide groups into numbered tables (there may be more tables than groups).

- 4. Discuss and answer the question for 20-30 minutes.
- 5. Then move on to the next table in the order of numbering, and repeat the rotation until all questions have been answered.
- 6. Allow time for group feedback and synthesis.
- 7. Complete the mind map
